



Recognising Student Achievement:



Students involved: 5 – 6

SLC students will not 7C's awards.

Students may be eligible to receive awards in the following categories at the end of each semester:

1. Sports Colours
2. Arts Colours
3. Academic Colours
4. Community Colours

Students will demonstrate point total evidence to teachers during House meetings.

Eligibility

- Demonstrate a clear record of cooperation as a member of the school.
- Suspension or significant detentions may render a student ineligible to gain points for one term.
- Demonstrate a consistent record of attendance at school events – Apple Fair, House Days.
- Full participation and attendance in relevant events for each category.
- Full compliance with school dress code for specific categories.

Application

- Students apply for badges on the pro-forma available from the SLC.
- Applications should be supported by appropriate documentation.
- Applications for semester two start week one in term one and close at the end of that week. Applications for semester one start week one in term three and close at the end of that week.
- Seconded staff members in a student's house will review all applications.
- Colours will be badges and will be awarded during assemblies.

1. Sport Colours

- Accumulate 100 points based on participation in one or more of the following activities over a period of two years.
- Participation in non-school teams or as an individual at any level will not accumulate points towards colours.

Sport Colours	
Activity	Points
Participate in all school sport activities during the calendar year – This includes: swimming, cross country, lightning premierships and athletics.	10
Athletics age group champion.	10
Swimming sports age group champion.	10
Cross country age group champion.	10
Member of a school sport team such as a lightning premierships team, basketball, soccer, netball, cricket.	5
* Each level of student achievement or representation (District, Zone, Region and State) attracts an additional 5 points.	

2. Art Colours

- Accumulation of 100 points for participation in extra-curricular school productions, music activities and/or extra as events listed.
- Involvement in these events must involve significant practice, preparation and performance time and an 80% attendance record.
- Proof of hours contributed must be documented and verified by supervising teacher at the time of application.
- Participation in non-school performing art's events as a group or as an individual at any level will not accumulate points towards colours.

3. Academic Colours

1. Accumulate 100 points based on participation in one or more of the following activities over a period of two years.

Activity	Points
Participation in external academic competitions e.g. UNSW.	5
Member of school debating team.	15
Achievement of three or more As in a semester.	15
Participation with attendance @90% or above at a school academic club.	10
Completion of the Premier's Reading Challenge.	15
95- 100% for the semester	10
Mathletics' certificates: bronze, silver and gold	1, 5, 10
* Each level of student achievement or representation of debating (District, Zone, Region and State) attracts an additional 5 points.	

4. Community Colours

1. Accumulate 100 points based on participation in one or more of the following activities over a period of two years.

Attendance at a school working bee.	10
Rotary Leadership completed.	20
Student School Council Representative and 80% attendance at meetings.	10
Positive Classroom Behaviour (Less than 8 rule reminders for the semester).	10

Participation in Walk/Ride to School Day.	5
ANZAC Day parade attendance at the Ocean Grove commemorative service.	10
