The School Council is committed to creating a culture of inclusion for all of our students, staff, and broader school community at OGPS. In order to effect real change in our school community an Inclusion Subcommittee has been formed with the specific aims of;

- Investigating how we can improve our current levels of knowledge and inclusiveness of our local Indigenous heritage and embrace and embed this within our school community.
- Investigating how we can improve our current levels of knowledge and inclusiveness of LGBTIQ+ members of our community.
- Learning more about how we can improve our current levels of inclusiveness of people with a disability in our school community.
- Developing a culturally, racially, disability, religiously and gender inclusive environment.

The Inclusion Subcommittee was formed in August 2020 as a reflection of the school's commitment to inclusivity and is chaired by a member of School Council (currently parent member Miriam Leahy).
